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**Tenure**





**Termination**

Subject: Architecture Students' Workshops for School Children in Sketching and Model Making

**Introduction:**

On December 18, 2020, the Department of Architecture at JBRAC organized a series of workshops for school children aimed at introducing them to the fundamentals of sketching and model making. Led by a group of enthusiastic architecture students, these workshops provided an opportunity for school children to explore their creativity, develop thinking skills.

**Objectives:**

1. To introduce school children to the basics of sketching and model making.
2. To inspire creativity and imagination among school children through hands-on activities.
3. To promote collaboration and mentorship between architecture students and school children.

**Workshop Overview:**
